The Miami County Board of Commissioners, at its General Session today, accepted the resignation of D. Craig Thompson, Department of Development Director. The resignation is effective September 2, 2016.

Thompson became the County's Department of Development Director on September 2, 2014.

Craig Thompson thanked the Board for the opportunity and said, "The department is in good hands with the staff in place until the new Director is found."

"A timetable for the search and hire of a new Miami County Development Director will be discussed by the Board and released at a later date. We have been successful in the past finding these types of professionals and I'm confident this search be met with the same success," Commissioner John O'Brien added.
