DIRECTIONS: West Central Juvenile Detention Center is located at 2044 N. Co. Rd. 25a, Troy, OH 45373. From I-75 take exit #78 and turn right. West Central is about two miles south of the exit in the Miami County Government Complex.

PHONE CALLS: Residents are permitted to call their parent / guardian using the Inmate Phone System. This will be a collect call. The person receiving the call has the choice to accept or decline the charges. Residents are not permitted incoming calls.

VISITATION: Only parents /legal guardian, stepparents and grandparents may visit. Visitation is by appointment only on Wednesday evening, Saturday and Sunday afternoon for 20 minutes. Other children are not allowed to enter the secure area and should not be brought to a visit. Call (937) 440-3485 #8401 to schedule a visit. A photo ID is required to enter the facility. All visitors will undergo security screening before entering the secure area.

NEEDS: Parents will need to provide a pair of gym shoes and any prescription medication for the youth during their stay. All other needs are provided by the facility for the youth.

MAIL: Residents are provided writing material to correspond with parents and grandparents. If they choose to write to anyone else, parents will have to supply paper, envelopes and stamps for such. When mailing cards or letters to a youth inside this facility, remember to put their name on the outside of the envelope.

READING MATERIAL: Books can be brought in for youth to read. No magazines are accepted. Any reading books brought in will remain the property of WCJDC upon release of youth.

EDUCATION: Parents are encouraged to bring school books and assignments to the JDC for the youth to work on while here. Our teachers work very hard to maintain each student's home assignments. The goal is to keep students up to date on assignments for return to their home

school.
