Salary Information: Starting pay is \$17.44/hr or \$39,484.15 annually, including ten paid holidays. We offer shift differentials for working night shift 6p-6a.

Description: Juvenile Corrections Officers with the West Central Juvenile Detention Facility are responsible for the intake, release, and daily observation of youth who are placed in the facility via a court order or pursuant to the laws of arrest. The facility operates with thirty five (35) full and part time staff on twelve (12) hour shifts thus granting every other weekend off. Corrections Officers oversee daily activities with youth to include but not limited to: personal hygiene, education, physical education, recreation, communication with parents, and escorts to meals.
